## Program Overview

- A whole farm support services program offering transitioning farmers training and resources that address soil health, climate resilience and business management.



## Outcomes

- Over three years transitioned 57 farms representing 10,000+ acres
- Develop over 100 resources available to farmers
- Track progress via soil and ecological indicator data collection



## Activities

- Hold on-farm training days that includes community and business stakeholders
- Facilitate farmer to farmer sharing and regional communities of practice
- Offer business management services to help increase farm profits
- Connect regional agri-food businesses with growers to align respective goals
